What is a Ribbon Cutting?

A **Ribbon Cutting Event** is an important part of your overall marketing and advertising plan, and is a great way to kick-off a **Grand Opening** of a business.

If you are a Scotts Valley Chamber of Commerce member your business is eligible for a Ribbon Cutting event if the company has:

- Opened its doors in the last 6 months.
- Changed ownership or is under new management.
- Has been expanded or remodeled.
- Moved to a new location.

The Scotts Valley Chamber of Commerce would enjoy assisting you in planning a successful event for your company. Having participated in hundreds of Ribbon Cutting Events, we know how to get optimum exposure for your company.

The ceremony itself is conducted by the Chamber's Executive Director and the Ambassador Committee. The Ribbon Cutting Event comes complete with a large pair of scissors, large red ribbon, and photos to commemorate the opening. The event begins with a welcome statement *before* the Ribbon Cutting. The photos taken appear in the *Scotts Valley Chamber Newsletter*, local newspapers and social media! The event also offers an opportunity to meet dignitaries in the Community.

Schedule a Ribbon Cutting

Ribbon Cuttings are usually scheduled two months in advance. The Chamber's Board of Directors, Ambassadors, and dignitaries and Councilmembers of Scotts Valley are invited to attend the celebration along with people you've invited.



Hors d'oeuvres and beverages are usually served and plans can be as elaborate or as simple as you'd like – whatever fits your budget!
